

WE CAN DO IT

This year, Together's observation courses will be different - we're going online!

The health crisis modifies our daily non formal education and learning practices.

With more solidary actions, more online activities. But also an increase of social inegality, poverty, intolerence, acts of discriminations.

What is Together we can do it?

An Erasmus program of training, reciprocal learning and analysis of practices, for actors of non formal education working for inclusion and social justice in their country. This program pursues an objective of producing knowledge drawn from the experience of all the participants, shared through a capitalization tool in the form of a web documentary, in order to spread the lessons within the national and international network and among the nonformal education sector.

What has been done?

- ► 5 face-to-face observation courses
- **▶** which gathered 100 participants
- ► from 4 different countries and organizations
- ► 1 webdocumentary

What to expect from an online observation course?

Come experiment and create with us what an online course can be! We are not professionals in digital tools, but we will do our best to create an atmosphere conducive to learning and exchanging practices.

- ► A european experience : participants from 4 different countries speak about empowerment.
- **Discovery of a local** culture, of a context and a way of working.
- **Exchanges of practices** between european peers.
- ► Meetings and talks with local volunteers or beneficiaries.
- ► Virtual tours, online workshops...

What is expected from participants?

Each observation course is a process

Like in face-to-face observation course, there are different steps: moment to learn to know each others, moment to discover a project, moment to exchange with the other participants or with the hosting team. The participant should register for the all observation course and participate to all the sessions.

Each observation course is an occasion to produce contents for the webdoc

The webconferences are built to permit exchanges. At the end of each session or at the end of the week, the participants can be asked to answer questions, to evaluate, to give their point of view about what they have seen. This can be used to enrich the webdoc.
